COVID-19 Independent Living Resident **Update 07-08-2020**

UPDATE: We do have been notified of a new case of a resident confirmed COVID positive in our Fellowship Square Historic Mesa independent living.

Residents and staff that may have had close contact with this resident will be notified individually and encouraged to get tested. We will continue to monitor and follow best practices and stay current with guidelines from the CDC, AZDHS and Maricopa County Health Department. Even with all the precautions, risk of contracting the virus remains. ***The two residents reported last week that are positive for COVID19 are now out of quarantine. The one staff member that tested positive is self-quarantining at home.*** Staff, residents and visitors are required to wear masks and follow infection control policies to minimize exposure to others.

Please contact your primary care physician for information on testing if you are concerned. Testing is also available locally at FastMed urgent care and CVS. Residents may call life enrichment for transportation information to testing sites. Residents are asked to report any positive results so our staff can take precautions and of course they would need to self-quarantine.

We promise to be transparent and forthcoming, as situations develop and change. Updates will be communicated timely via hand delivered notices and on Channel 1960 as well as our website.
