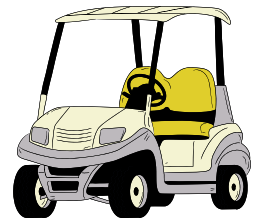
For **individual transportation to medical appointments**, our ADA van is available on a **reservation basis**.

# Transportation Guidelines



When on Fellowship Square Historic Mesa buses or vans:

- Seat belts must be worn at ALL times.
- You must be able to transfer and sit in one of the seats unless you have reserved a scooter/wheelchair spot.
- All riders must remain seated until the vehicle comes to a complete stop.
- Shopping bags must be limited to 4 per person.
- Riders should be at the bus stop 15 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.
- There is one bus stop outside each community/dining room to be used for bus, van or golf cart riders. We are unable to pick up at apartments.
- Riders must be on board and ready to depart at the scheduled return time.
- Failure to comply may result in loss of transportation privileges.
