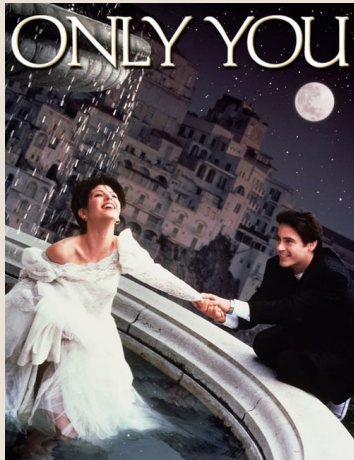

1. The man Valentine's Day was named for was probably two men. One St. Valentine and the other a priest in the third century named Valentine.
2. It became an official holiday in the 1300's and was associated with love.
3. Cupid comes from the 700's BC and was a Greek god who had love-matching powers.
4. The first valentine was sent in the 15th century written by a French duke named Charles to his wife in 1415.
5. 1840 was the first time Valentine's Day cards were mass produced and sold in the United States.
6. Giving flowers on Valentine's Day dates back to the 17th Century and the flower of choice was a red rose, symbolizing deep love.
7. The color of flower given on Valentine's Day holds meaning. Not only did a red rose mean deep love but also a deep pink rose—happiness; a purple rose—royalty and a white rose—sympathy.
8. Americans spent nearly \$26 billion on Valentine's Day gifts in 2023 and the average person spends \$193.00 on Valentine's Day.
9. Americans send 145 million Valentines cards yearly.
