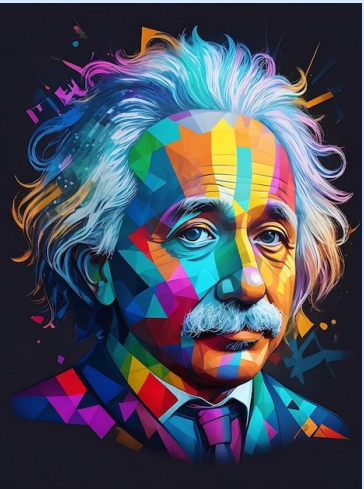

Testimony. A word we typically associate with judicial circumstances and court cases. In fact, when I looked up the word testimony in the *Dictionary of Jesus and the Gospels* it directed me to the term witness. A witness is a person who knows the truth and can testify before a court of law, declaring what has been seen or heard. The definition continues by saying the witness theme occupies a place of considerable importance in the Bible. Witnesses throughout the Bible can certify facts. Unfortunately, they can also prove to be false or malicious witnesses; these are frequently condemned in biblical literature. The Gospels speak of witness as themes of testimony and confession. In the Fourth Gospel, witness is a central theme. Within the book of John there are several witnesses that capture the essence of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. These include John the Baptist, the disciples, the Scriptures, the mighty works of Christ, and the Father. All offer testimony on behalf of Christ. This evidence, unfortunately, fails to convince opponents unless it is accompanied by the inward witness of the Holy Spirit. When the Holy Spirit comes, he drives home the truth. The last day of this month is Easter. Within the Easter narrative lies all the thoughts, people, places and circumstances of Jesus as the risen savior. Proverbs 12:17a ***“A truthful witness gives honest testimony.”*** Through the Holy Spirit we have the assurance of the gift of everlasting life. We know that Jesus’ life, death, burial, resurrection, and ascension affords this union and sacred reunion with Christ in his second coming. Until then, we are reminded of John’s words in 1 John 5:9-13 which speaks of our faith in Jesus as the Son of God. ***“We accept human testimony, but God’s testimony is greater because it is the testimony of God, which he has given about his Son. Whoever believes in the Son of God accepts this testimony. Whoever does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because they have not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.”*** Praise God! This Easter, our testimony, by the leading of the Holy Spirit, should be to witness of the love of God and His sacrifice on the cross for the remission of sin and the gift of everlasting life. May you have a Happy Easter.
