Renter's Insurance: We strongly recommend that our residents purchase renter's insurance upon move-in.

TV/Cable: Basic Cable is included in your monthly rent (70 channels). Upgraded TV/Cable packages may be purchased directly through a cable provider.

Internet: Free Internet & computers are available in the Computer Center. Free WiFi is available in certain common areas. To set up Internet service in your apartment, contact Internet provider directly.

Social Events & Activities: Most activities and social events on campus are free. For trips off campus, such as attending live theater, museums or other attractions, residents pay for their admission tickets and incidentals (souvenirs, for example).

Dining Out: Monthly rent includes 15 lunches or dinners each month, per resident. Additional meals in the main dining room are \$12 each for residents and guests. Items in the Bistro are priced individually.
