Notes regarding variable items:

Renter's Insurance: We strongly recommend that our residents purchase renter's insurance upon move-in.

TV/Cable: Extended Cable is included in monthly rent (includes music channels). Upgraded TV/Cable packages may be purchased directly through cable provider.

Internet: Free WiFi & computers are available in the Learning Center & Activities. To set up Internet service in your apartment, contact Internet provider directly.

Social Events & Activities: Most activities and social events on campus are free. For some trips off campus, such as attending live theater, museums or other attractions, residents pay for their admission tickets and incidentals (souvenirs, for example).

Dining Out: Monthly rent includes 25 meals/month per resident. Additional meals in the main dining room are \$12 each for residents and guests. Menu items in the Garden Café are priced à la carte.
