

CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

The dating of Easter came about by the First Council of Nicaea in 325 AD, setting it apart from the Jewish Passover.

Sunrise service has been practiced as early as the First Century.

Lillies were chosen as the Easter flower due to a belief that they grew in the garden where Jesus was buried.

From the start of the Church, the cross was part of the Resurrection observance.

So, how about you, what are some of your Easter traditions, and have they changed over the years? As a young child in our home, it was a morning filled with the hope of those anticipated brightly colored eggs, too much candy, chocolate bunnies, and a new Easter outfit for church! Yet as I got older the impact of the Easter basket goodies and traditions became less, as the transformational truth of the Resurrection became more!

God's word tells us that Jesus died a tragic martyr's death on a Friday (Good Friday), a death that was not unexpected but anticipated; for the hand of God was involved. And through this prophesied martyr's death on the cross, came also on the 3rd day, a Sunday morning resurrection (Easter); The tomb was empty, "for He has risen, as he said."

Brothers and sisters, whatever may have stemmed your Easter traditions, may the promise of the Easter resurrection bring you the renewed hope of our risen Savior Jesus; and fill your hearts with His healing peace, comfort, and joy.
