Gerry was a nurse in the Army Nurse Corps during WWII in Europe. She was a second lieutenant in the MASH unit/surgical evacuation hospital. Gerry followed the ground troops across Europe, mainly in Belgium. They lived in tents and followed the troops in Jeeps.



She served for about 2 years before VE Day. Her unit was preparing to go to the Pacific Theater at the time President Truman ordered the atomic bombs to be dropped on Japan, and that ended the war. Gerry then went back to school to become a nurse anesthetist. She finished her career at the VA hospital in Tucson.
