Happy New Year

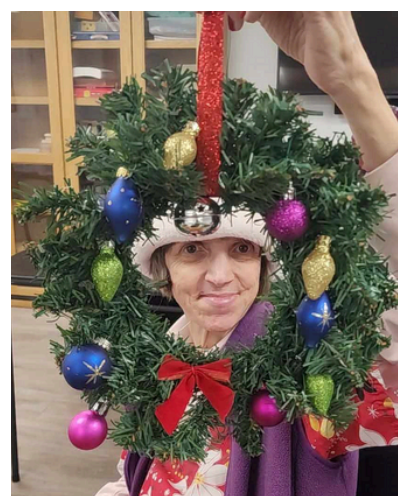
