DANCES WITH WOLVES

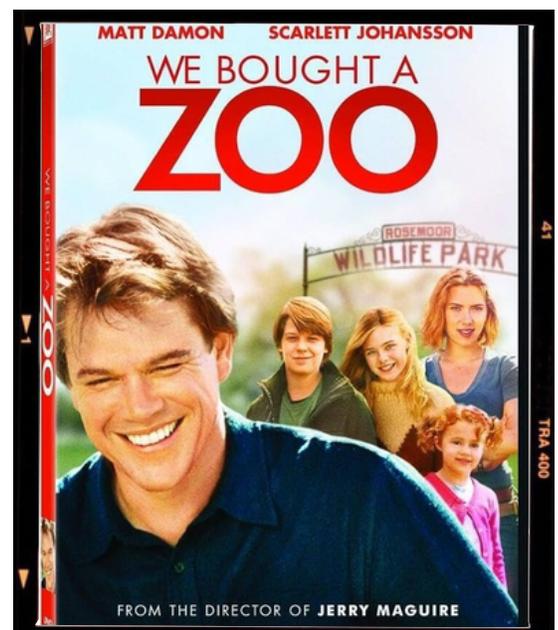
SATURDAY, MARCH 7TH | 1:00 PM
