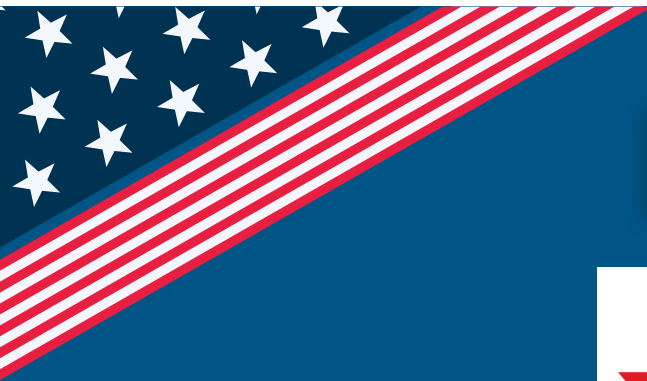


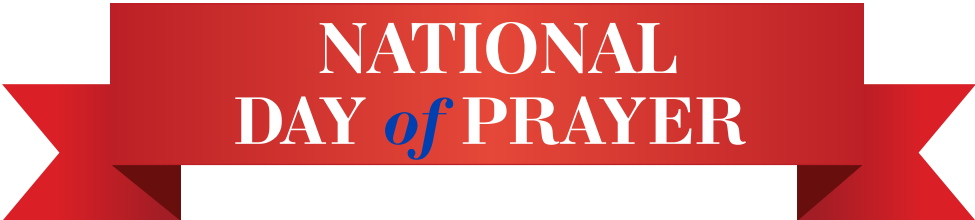

The story follows Pete “Maverick” Mitchell (Tom Cruise), a daring but reckless young fighter pilot who is sent to the elite training facility to refine his skills. There, he clashes with the disciplined “Iceman” (Anthony Edwards) and other pilots, while also developing a romantic connection with his civilian flight instructor, Ilsa “Viper” Vostok (Kelly McGillis). The film mixes intense dogfight sequences between American and Soviet jets with personal drama, culminating in a climactic aerial battle.

TOP GUN MAVERICK

MONDAY, MAY 25TH | 2:00 PM

After more than thirty years of service as one of the U.S. Navy’s top naval aviators, Maverick is a fearless test pilot pushing the limits of flight. However, he must return to TOP GUN to train a group of elite graduates for a specialized mission, one that will require the ultimate sacrifice from those chosen to fly it. When Maverick reunites with Lt. Bradley “Rooster” Bradshaw (Miles Teller), the son of his late wingman “Goose,” bitter rivalries ignite. As the pilots prepare for the mission, Maverick confronts the ghosts of his past and the immense pressure of leading a team on a task no living pilot has ever attempted.

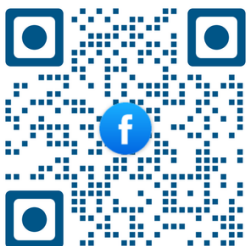
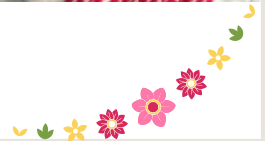

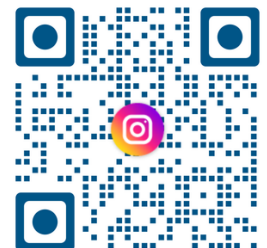
