Expanded Fitness Space and New Bocce Ball Court for Active Living

Thanks to the generosity of residents and the support of Fellowship Square leadership, two exciting improvements have recently been completed: an expanded fitness center and a beautiful new bocce ball court in Villa 1.

The **fitness center expansion** reflects something important we all know, but often have to remind ourselves of: taking care of our bodies matters at every stage of life. The updated space now provides more room for movement, balance, and strength through the wellness classes led by our awesome Wellness Coordinator, Logan. With extended mirrors and

balance bars, residents now have a safer, more comfortable environment to stay active, build confidence, and support long-term health. The goal is simple—make it easier for more people to participate and feel good doing it.

In Villa 1, residents will also find a **new bocce ball court** located near the barbecue area, replacing the former shuffleboard space. With nearby seating and a festive gathering area, it is designed to be more than a place to play—it is a place to connect. Our Director of Resident Experience, Michelle Hernandez, is already working with residents to organize regular bocce activities, so watch for opportunities to join the fun.

What makes these projects especially meaningful is how they came to life. Residents stepped forward with generous financial contributions because they believed in enhancing life for their neighbors and strengthening the community we all share. Additional support from Fellowship Square leadership helped bring these projects to completion.

These improvements are more than new amenities. They are examples of what can be accomplished when residents, staff, and supporters work together toward a common goal. New Pool Access Chair Providing Safer Access to the Pool

At Fellowship Square, meaningful improvements often begin with a simple question: how can we make daily life safer, easier, and more enjoyable for our residents?

Thanks to the thoughtful generosity of one of our residents, we are pleased to share a new addition to our pool area that will significantly improve accessibility for those who want to enjoy the water.

The new Aqua Creek pool access chair is designed to assist individuals with safely transferring into and out of the pool. Built with a sturdy PVC frame and a 350-pound weight capacity, it provides a stable, supportive option for entering and exiting the pool. While it is not a one-size-fits-all solution, it meaningfully expands access for residents who have found the existing ramp difficult or, in some cases, impossible to use.



For years, pool access has been a challenge for some members of our community. This new chair helps address that challenge by offering another important option for participation in water-based wellness activities.

What makes this improvement especially meaningful is the intention behind it. A fellow resident saw a barrier that others experience every day and chose to quietly step forward to help remove it. That kind of generosity reflects a deep care for neighbors and a sincere commitment to improving life for others in our community. In keeping with the donor's request for anonymity, we are simply grateful for the difference this gift will make every time someone enters the pool.

As with many of the improvements at Fellowship Square, this enhancement came to life through resident generosity, thoughtful collaboration, and the support of the Advancement Office working alongside leadership and staff. It is another example of what becomes possible when residents invest in one another and in the shared spaces that define our community.

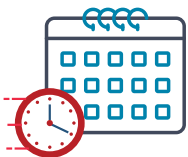
