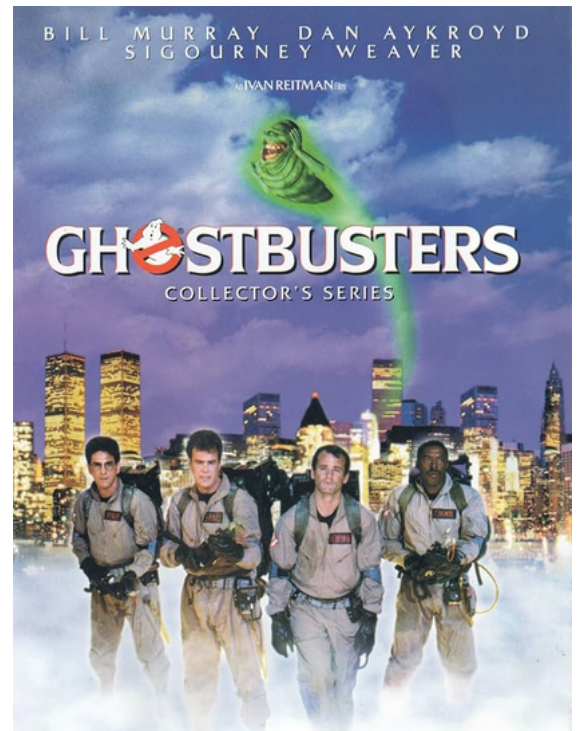
Directed and produced by Richard Correll, the film was produced by 120dB Films and Gerson Productions.

Their history includes their traditional ways of life, forced removal, struggles with the U.S. government, and their continued efforts to protect their language, traditions, and land.

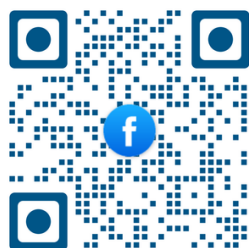

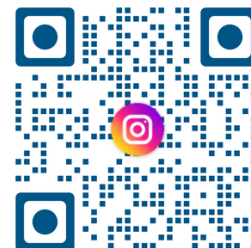
